## Sasthrayan 2018- Report

Sasthrayan 2018 was conducted on 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> February 2018 in the college campus. The programme was inaugurated by the Hon'ble MP Dr.ShashiTharoor. Shri Vincent (MLA Kovalam), Kanjiramkulam Panchayat President, Panchayat Members, representative of RUSA, Principal Dr. S. A. Shajahan, Vice Principal, and Teachers were presented in the inaugural session.



At the outset, Hon'ble MP described the importance of Sasthrayan project in Universities and Colleges. He opined that, the relevance of the project is to develop the scientific and technical skills of students in the colleges.

As per the direction of the Principal, different sub committees such General Committee, Inauguration Committee, Reception Committee, Publicity Committee, Finance Committee etc. were formed for the smooth functioning of the project. All the major and minor departments in the college were participated in the Sasthrayan projectwith exhibition, Seminars, Medical camps, Quiz competition, Awareness classes, Interactive Sessions with public and students etc.,.
